



SilverLite Trailers, Inc. hereinafter SilverLite, warrants its products to be free from defects in materials and workmanship for a period of five (5) years from the date of purchase for a Bandit or Trailblazer horse trailer or for a period of ten (10) years from the date of purchase for all other horse and living quarters trailers. Any trailer covered under this warranty used in a commercial application is limited to a warranty period of one (1) year from the date of purchase. This warranty applies to the Original Purchaser, from the Original Purchase Date. Except as noted below, such warranty extends only to the original purchaser (the first person, firm or entity to purchase the trailer from SilverLite or a SilverLite authorized dealer) upon satisfactory compliance with the conditions listed below:

- 1) The attached warranty documents must be filled in complete form with SilverLite Trailers, Inc. 1291 South A St, Springfield, OR 97477, postmarked within thirty (30) days of the original purchase date by the original purchaser. Failure to return the completed warranty document, postmarked within thirty (30) days of the original purchase date shall void this warranty in its entirety.
- 2) The warranty extended hereby covers only the frame assembly, i.e., the side rails, side and roof extrusions, floor cross beams and sub frame assemblies. Components such as living quarter interiors, doors, gates, dividers and such other material as are attached directly to the frame assembly shall be limited to one (1) year from the date of original purchase.
- 3) Components not manufactured by SilverLite are covered only by the warranties extended by the manufacturers of such components and not SilverLite. Such non-warranty components include, but are not limited to: tires wheels, axles, hubs, couplers, brakes, drums, jacks, springs, latches, windows, vents, hub caps, LQ appliances and all parts associated therewith. Requests for warranty adjustments on these items will be made directly to their manufacturers, whose names and addresses will be furnished by SilverLite to purchaser upon request.
- 4) No warranty is extended to damage caused by operator error in failing to torque tighten all lug nuts, check tire condition, braking abilities and all other conditions normally associated with normal trailer operation. Additionally, operator errors in failing to properly attach trailer to tow vehicle as prescribed by federal regulations and hitch specifications shall void any warranty otherwise made herein.
- 5) No warranty is extended for normal wear items, including but not limited to brakes, light bulbs, springs, mats, tires, brake linings and hoses.
- 6) This warranty shall not apply to damage due to loading in excess of the Gross Vehicle Weight Rating displayed on the trailer. Use of the trailer for any purpose not intended shall constitute misuse and shall void this warranty.
- 7) This warranty shall be automatically void if any modification to the trailer is made without prior written authorization for such from SilverLite.
- 8) Only a SilverLite authorized dealer who has received prior written authorization from SilverLite for such specific service or repair, or the SilverLite factory, shall be authorized to service or correct any defect in material or workmanship found in any trailer covered by this warranty.
- 9) Prior written authorization from SilverLite for any specific repairs and/or adjustments shall be received before any reimbursements will be made.
- 10) This warranty does not cover any economic loss including without limitation; payment for the loss of time or pay, inconvenience, loss of trailer use, trailer rental expense, lodging bills, meals, other travel costs, storage charges and other incidental or consequential loss or damage of any nature whatsoever.
- 11) SilverLite reserve the right to make design changes in trailers built and/or sold by them at any time without incurring any obligation to make the same or similar changes to trailers previously built, ordered, designed and/or sold by them.
- 12) This warranty shall apply, and service and/or repairs shall be made only upon receipt of prior written authorization by SilverLite. SilverLite, at its option, prior to approval for service and/or repairs pursuant to this warranty, may require delivery of the damaged part or trailer, freight pre-paid, to the SilverLite factory or to or from an alternate location SilverLite Trailers may designate as an approved location for inspection, service and/or repair of the damaged part or trailer.
- 13) This warranty may be transferred to a subsequent owner from the Original Purchaser for a transfer fee of \$250, paid to SilverLite Trailers, with the understanding that the succeeding owner acquires only the remainder of the warranty within the ten (10) year period from the original date of purchase.
